Late applications and late required documents will NOT be accepted for any reason.

*(IMPORTANT NOTE: Any non-voucher student currently attending Regis Catholic Schools may apply to the program only when entering kindergarten, 1st, and 9th grade.)* The St. Benedict Tuition Assistance Scholarship is also currently accepting applications and is based on financial need. To apply for the 2025-26 school year, a family must complete and submit the FACTS Grant & Aid Application by the deadline of April 17. This application is kept confidential by FACTS.
